The enactment of the Water Quality Accountability Act (WQAA) in October 2017, mandated that each water purveyor with more than 500 connections should identify the geographic location of each fire hydrant and water valve (except for the service connections and customer shut-off valves).

Furthermore, NJDEP has issued the final municipal storm water renewal permits for Tier A and B municipalities on November 9, 2017 that became effective January 1, 2018. Under the NJPDES MS4 general permit there is a requirement for the inspection, maintenance, and upkeep of several storm water management features such as culverts, outfalls and storm drain inlets.
